

# **Etail Systems Tip Sheet**


Objective: To add files such as PDFs, MP3s & YouTube videos to your products, or flags, such as small images highlighting something about your products.

The following tells you how to achieve this;-

#### <u>Files</u>

There are many different reasons as to why you may need to add a file to a product e.g. if products have manuals or safety guides with them, customers can download them directly from the product page.

To do this, you need to search for the product in Products > Product Search & click 'Edit Product'. To search for all products, click the 'Search' button without entering any search information.




You'll then need the 'Files & Flags' mini tab.



### **Product Specific Information**

If you want to upload a PDF or MP3 that's product specific, you can use the first box, 'Product Specific Files'. You can add a title to it if you wish. Choose your file & click 'Add New Product File'. You can add as many of these as you wish. You can update & remove them here also.

### Adding a file

If you have some products that have the same manual for example, the following might be easier than uploading the same file each time.

Go to Products > Files



You'll see you have the option to upload files, usually PDF, MP3, image or a video (you can also link from YouTube, please see later on in this walkthrough).

If you're not sure if your file type can be uploaded – try it & see! COMS will tell you if it can't accept it.

NB: If COMS throws an error message, try shortening your file name & reuploading if it's an accept file type.

Choose your file, & add some remarks to remind yourself what the file is (this won't be shown on the site) & a title (which is shown on the site), if you wish. If you want it to be a zoom image, tick the box. If you need a predefined width & height, enter that in the relevant boxes. Then click 'Add New File'.



If your upload is successful, your file will be uploaded & appear underneath.

If you need to edit your Remarks or Title, do this & then click the green 'update' button.

To suspend a file, click the red 'remove' button.




To set it live again, click the green 'add' button. To set it to dead, click the red 'x' button. This will remove it from all products it's associated with & delete it from the system.



### Adding a file to a product

To add one of these files to a product, go to the 'Files & Flags' mini tab in the 'Edit Product' menu, & go to the 'Common Files and Images' sub-heading.


Select the type of file you want to add from; Image, PDF, Unknown or Video.




A new dropdown will then appear under 'Remarks' – select which file you want from the dropdown menu & click 'Add File'.



Your files will then appear underneath – you can have as many files as you want attached to a product. To remove a file from the product, click the red 'remove' button.



It will look something like this on your product page, but will differ from site to site:




#### **Adding YouTube Videos**

There are two different ways of adding YouTube videos – the first is just creating a link that customers can click on to view the video in a pop-up on your product page, or by clicking a specific image.

#### Pop-up Video





Your Link Title will be the words the customer clicks on to view the pop-up, or if it's an image, it'll appear when a customer hovers over the image.

You'll be able to get your Embedded Code from the YouTube website – YouTube changes its interface quite often, so please ask if you're having trouble finding your code. Once you've added all your information, click 'Add Video'. It will look like this in COMS:



If you edit any text or code, click the green 'update' button to save your changes. If you want to remove the video from the product (this will delete all the information about that video from the product), click the red 'remove' button.

If you want to change the order of the videos on the site, use the dropdown under 'Display order' to change the numbers (1 being at the top), & click 'update'.

If you have an image on your site, instead of a link, it looks like this:



If you would like an image made, or you have an image to use for this, please let us know.

#### **Embedded Video**

If you would prefer to have videos actually embedded on your page (as below), follow the steps below:





Search for your product again, & click the 'Edit Product' button.

You'll probably have to enter the embedded code into the 'Extra Description' box, but please ask us about this, as it'll differ from site to site. This is in the 'Additional Info & Overrides' mini tab.



Just paste the embedded code there, scroll to the bottom & click the 'Update Product' button on the left.

If your video looks too big on the page, you should be able to edit the height & width of it in the code from within COMS. When you make a change, don't forget to click 'Update Product' again.

### Flags (Manual) - Product Page

Flags can be used to highlight something special about some of your products e.g. if you sell shoes & you have a matching item that can go with that item, you could have a flag (a little image) on your product page letting your customers know that particular shoe has matching items (& you should add these item to your related products on the product page).

To do this is the same as uploading **common product information**, but you'd upload this in the 'Flags' tab instead.



The uploading process & how you add it to a product is the same as a File.



### Flags (Automatic) - Product Page

There are automatic flags, which appear when certain conditions are met e.g. an item is out of stock. The options are listed below:
