## Adding a CSS Class to an article



## **Etail Systems Tip Sheet**

Objective: To add a CSS Class to an article.

The following tells you how to achieve this;-

A CSS Class can be a great way of making all your articles look consistent in the way they're styled. This does require some HTML to be implemented, so please ask for the 'Adding an Article' walkthrough if you need it.

Firstly, if you can mock up or get an article looking as close to what you want as you can, we can style this for you. Please tell us the name of the article you're trying to style, as we may need to adjust the HTML for you.

Once we've shown you your CSS Class & you're happy with it, you need to add it to all your articles that you want to look that way.

NB: You can only have one CSS Class per article, but you can have different CSS Classes throughout your site for different articles.

To set your CSS Class against an article, you'll need to go to Site Admin > Articles, then either click the 'Add New Article' button or edit an existing article but using the 'edit' button.



Once the cache has run out on your site, your article should now be styled according to the CSS Class.
